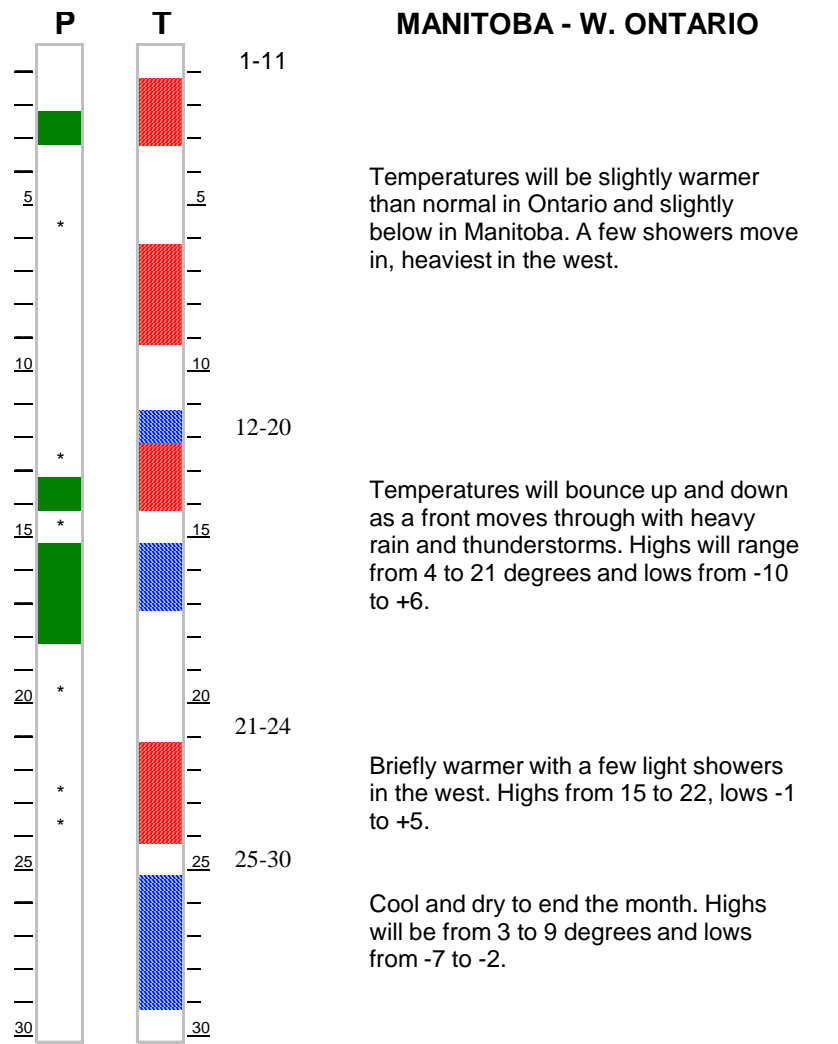
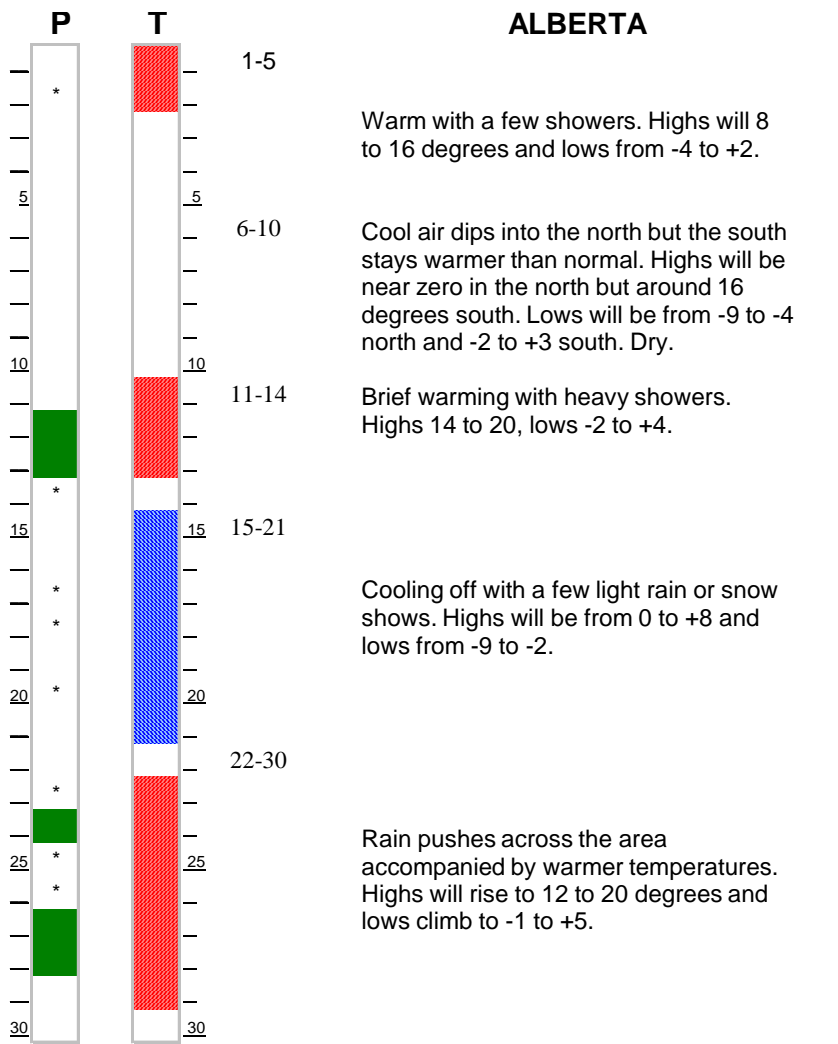
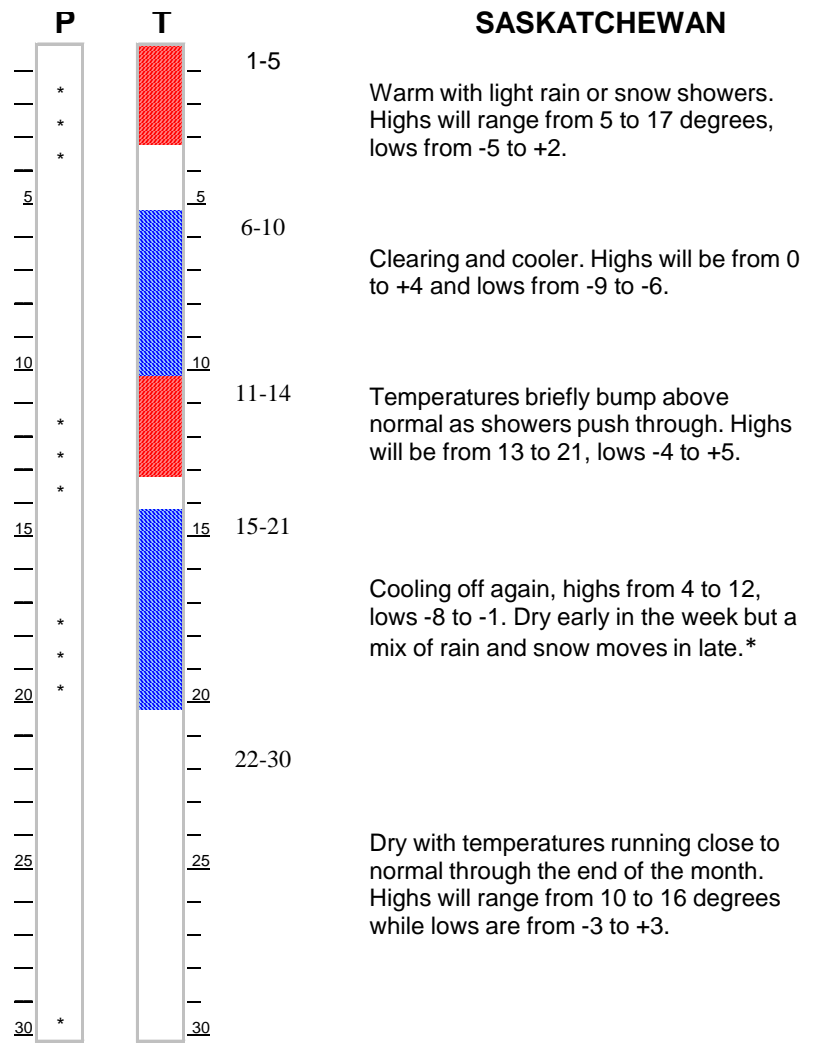
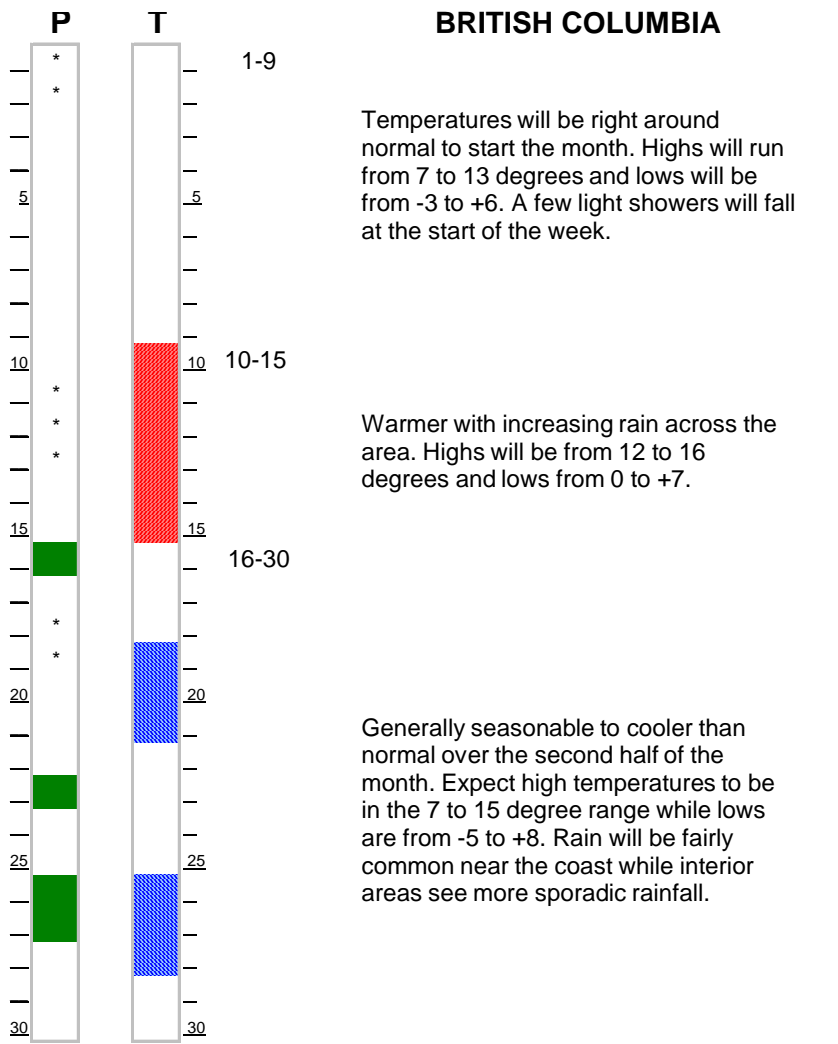
Precipitation



Monthly Climatic Outlook
