**Monthly Climatic Outlook**

Rainfall will be fairly light early in the month but pick up in intensity for the second half. British Columbia will see early and late showers with an extended dry spell in between.

Temperatures will run close to or above normal for most areas. The strongest anomalies will be found in eastern areas over the second half of the month.
