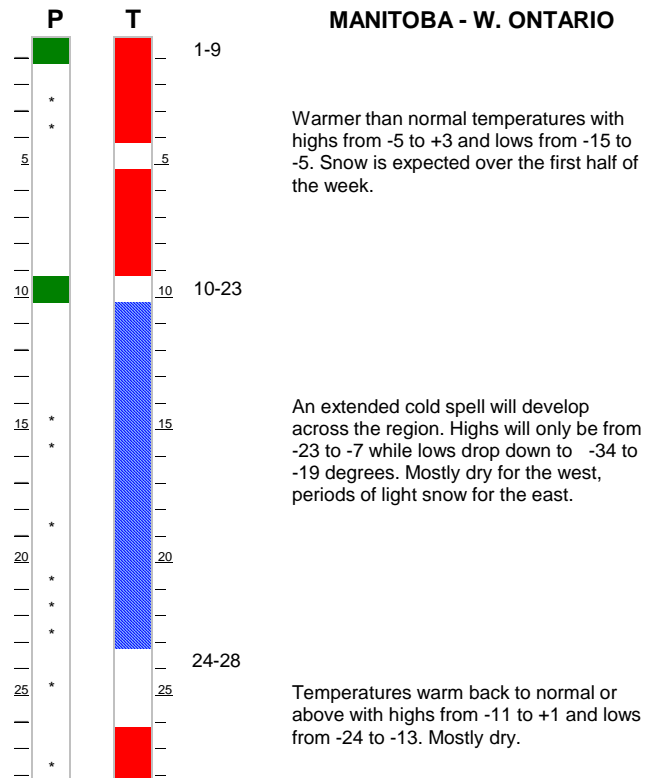
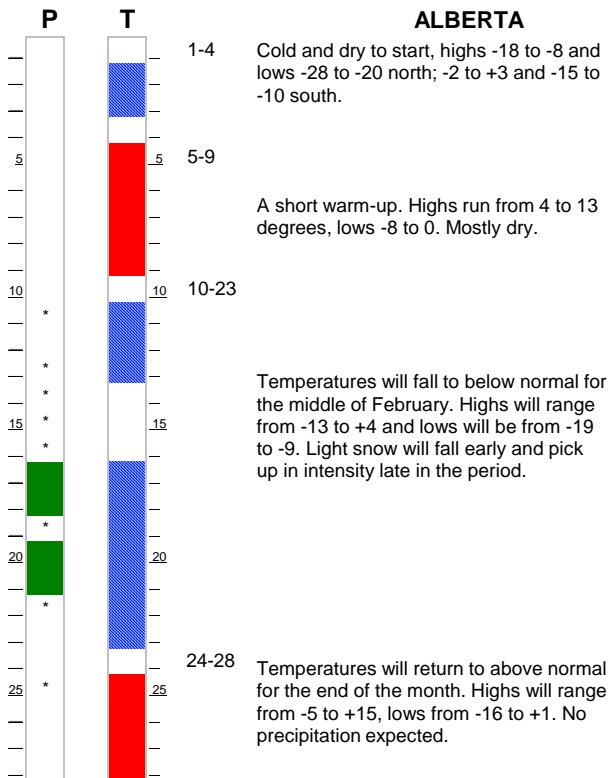
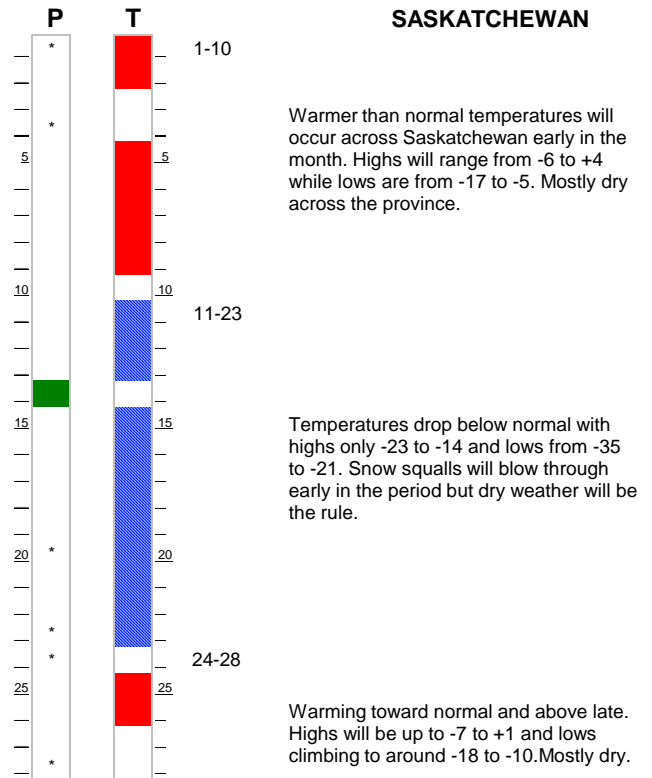
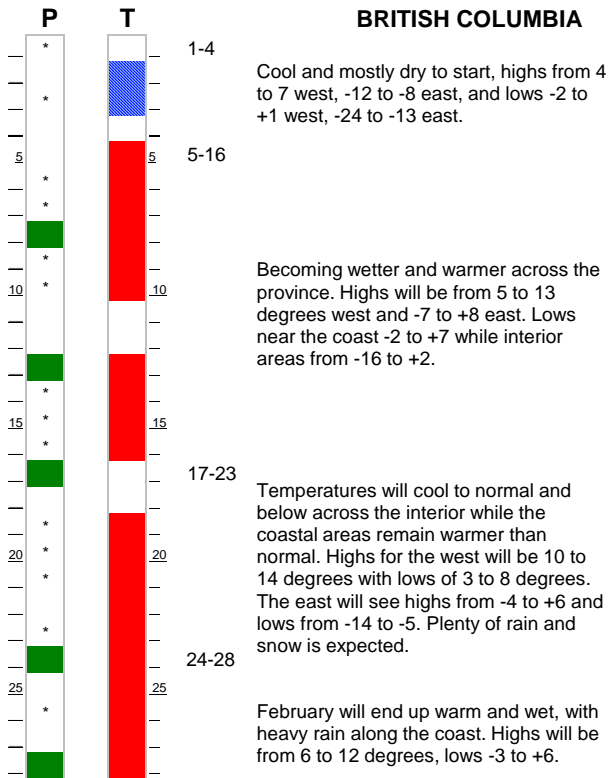


Monthly Climatic Outlook
