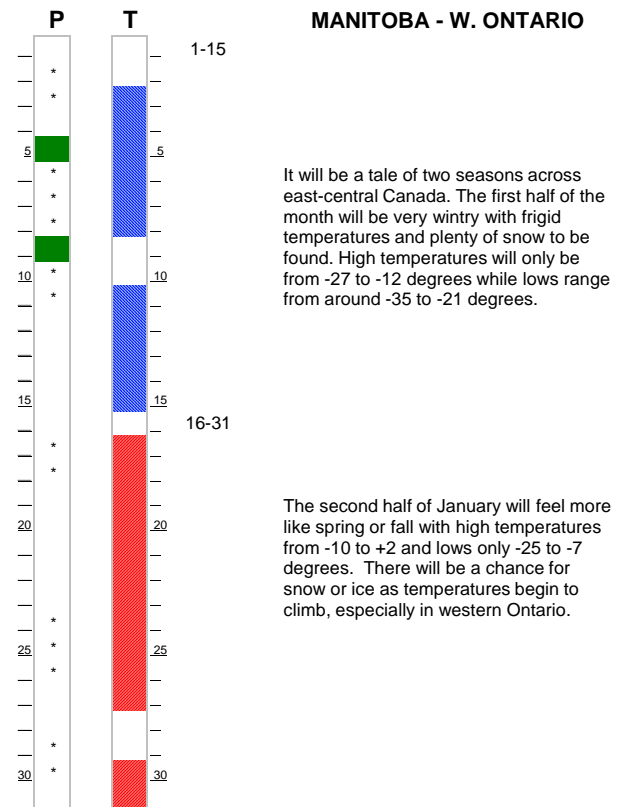
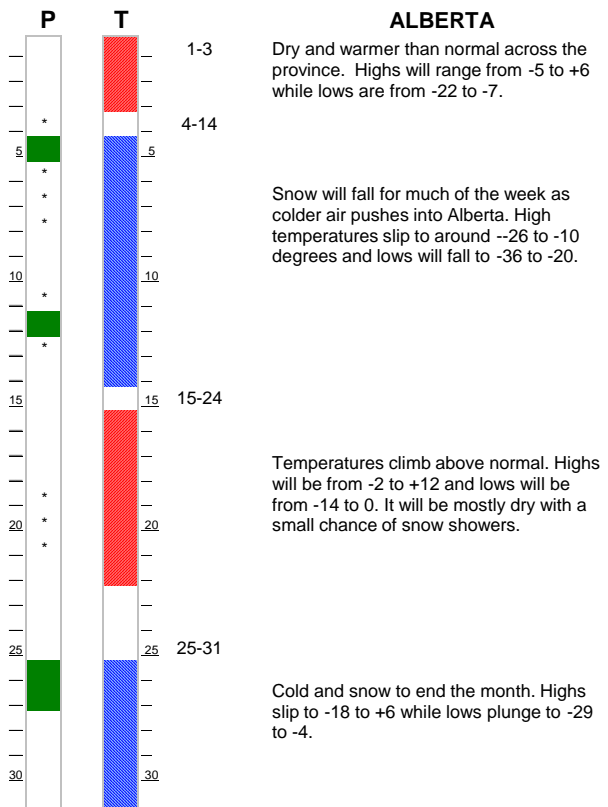
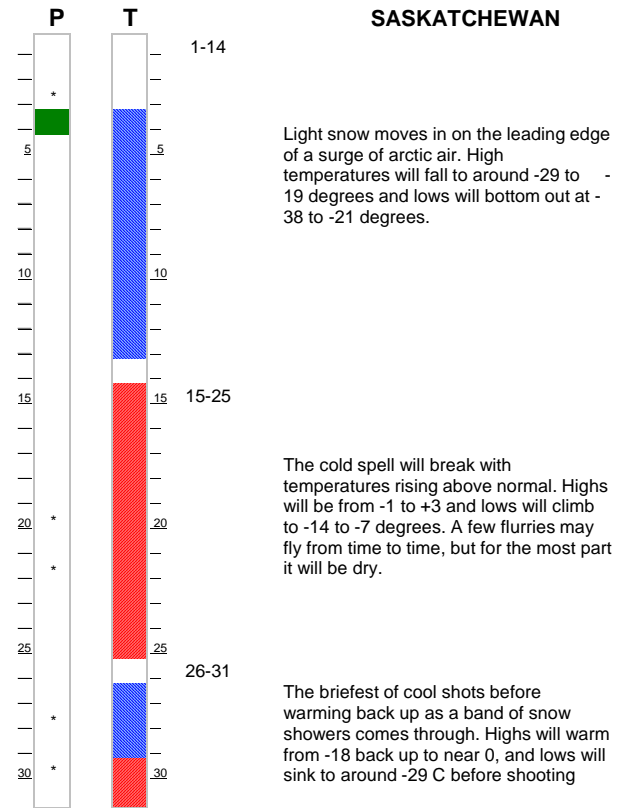
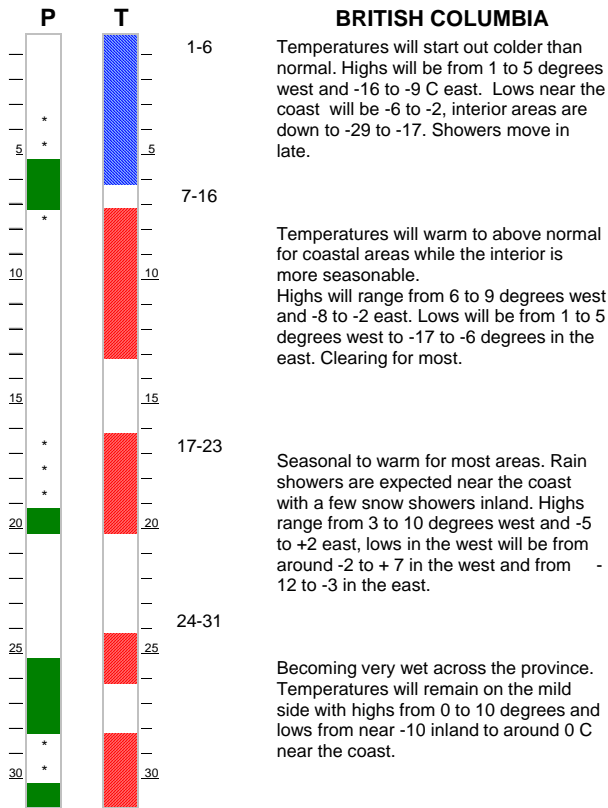
Monthly Climatic Outlook

British Columbia will see a bit of an up and down temperature pattern. For the Prairies it will mostly be a very cold first half, with a generous warming trend over the latter half of the month.

Plenty of snow is expected east of the Rockies, mainly early in the month. British Columbia can expect heavy rain/snow at the beginning and end of January.
