## Monthly Climatic Outlook

Temperatures are expected to be fairly mild through the winter due to the developing El Nino. Along with the mild conditions there should be fairly dry weather across the Prairies, but the Pacific will be open to rain and snow. Low pressure should be more common in the East leading to somewhat cooler and wetter weather.
