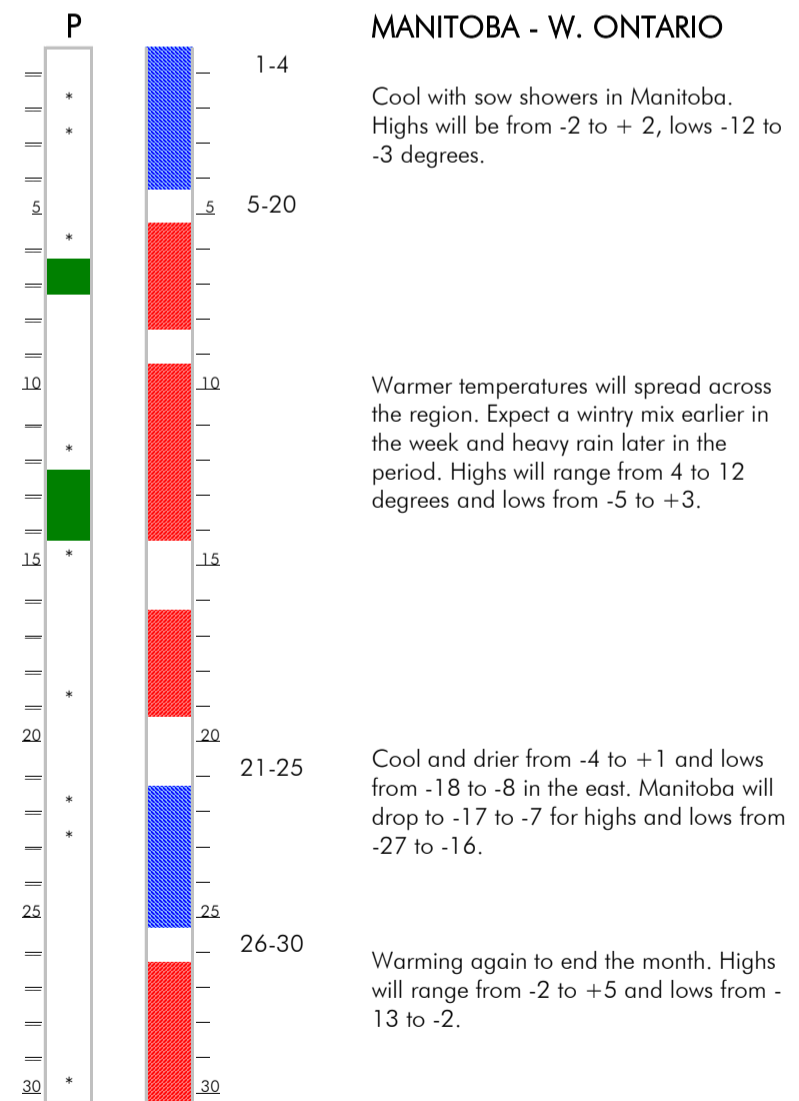
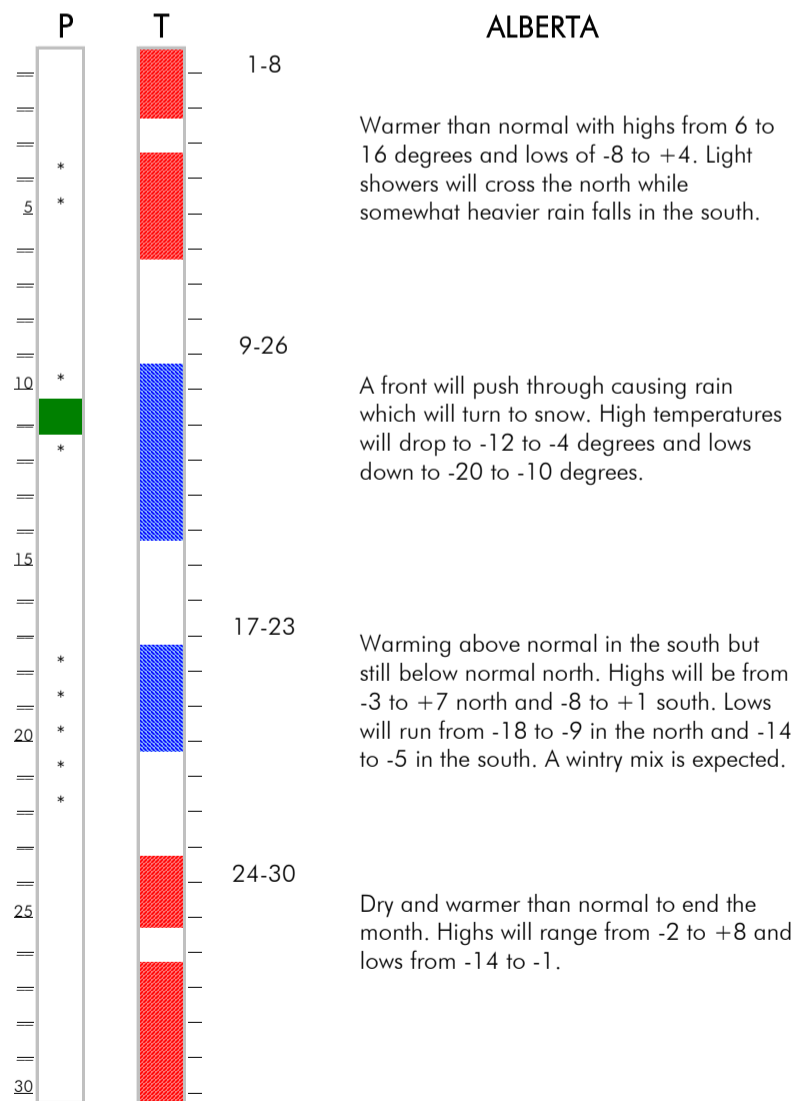
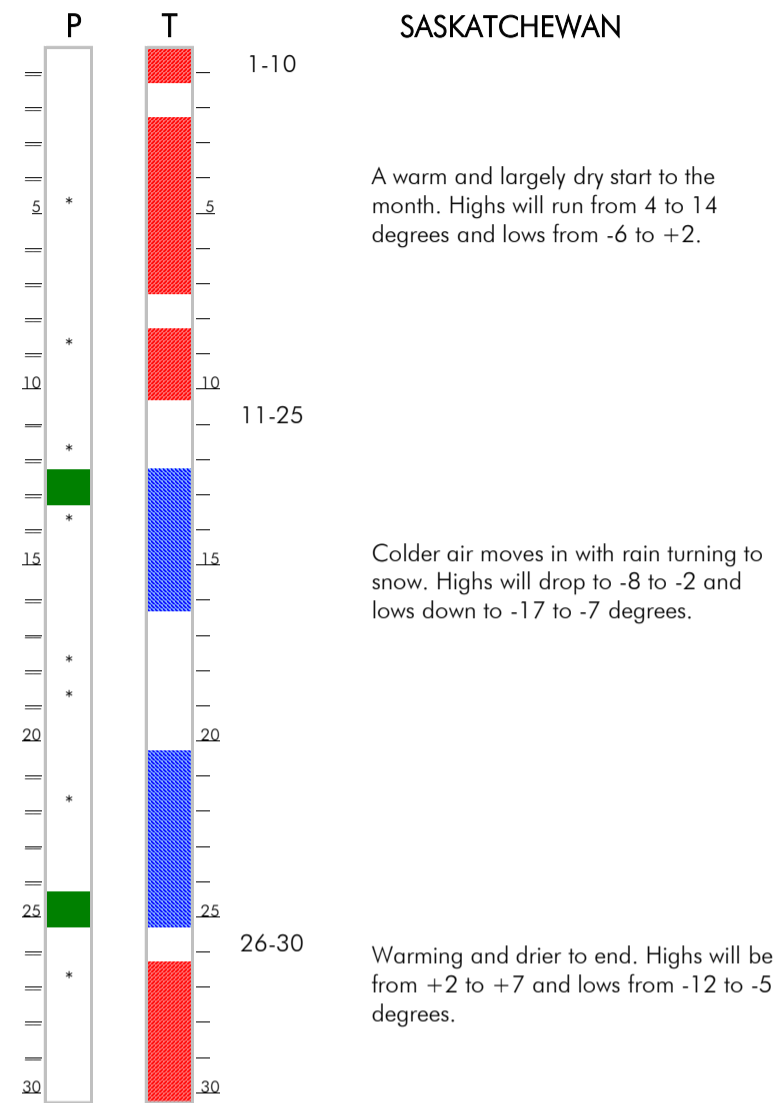
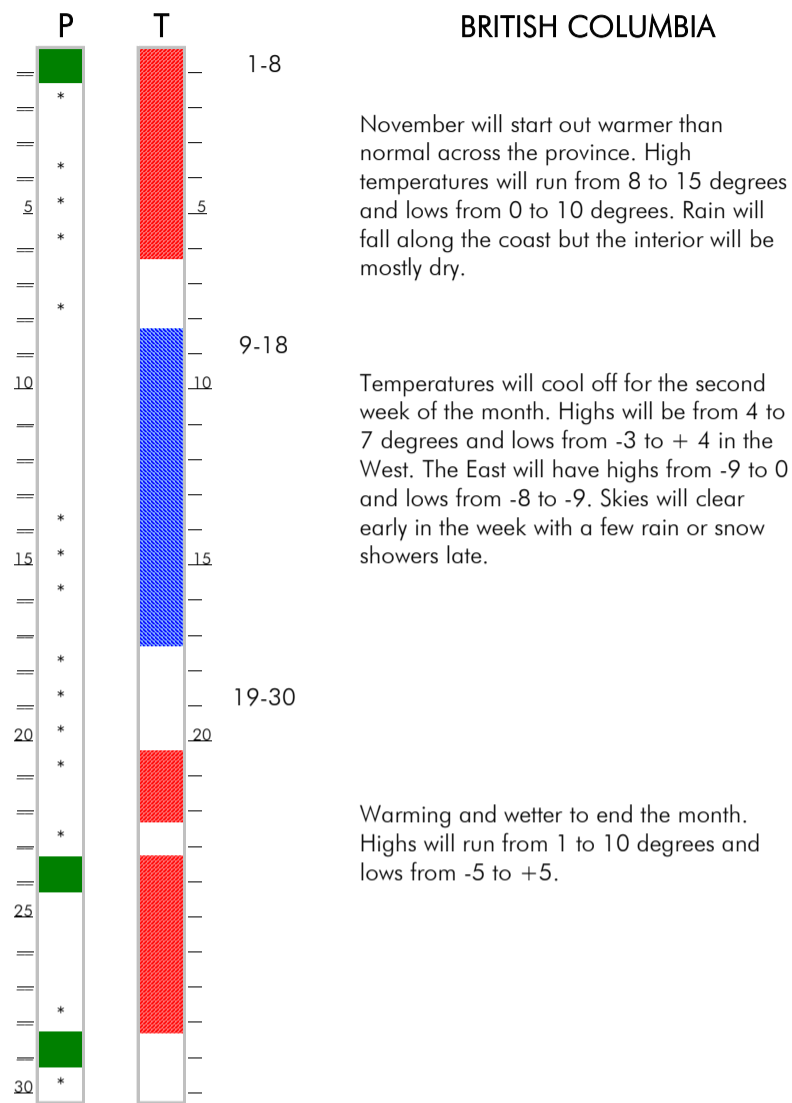
## Monthly Climatic Outlook
